# **Evictions**

## Types of notices:

### • 5 Day Notice:

Given for non-payment of rent, can be issued any time rent is unpaid.

#### • 10 Day Notice:

Given to residents that violate the lease provisions; for example having a pet in a pet free building.

## • 30 Day Notice:

Given to a person with a month to month or verbal lease no reason is required to give this type of notice.

#### Non-renewal letter:

A letter issued to the tenant (lessee) that the lease will not be renewed, typically 30 days prior to the end of the lease.

<ul> <li>You do not pay your rent.</li> <li>You violate terms of the lease.</li> <li>You allow people to stay in your apartment illegally (for example have a guest stay for a long time)</li> <li>You cause excessive damage to your unit or common areas.</li> <li>You are a nuisance to your neighbors.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>You ask for repairs to be done.</li> <li>You call the city's inspection department to complain about conditions and request an inspection.</li> <li>Your landlord does not like you.</li> <li>You are sick or disabled.</li> <li>You do not speak English well.</li> <li>You organize and meet with other neighbors regarding problems in your building.</li> </ul>
